# Focus on Healthy Weston

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# Background

- In October 2017 the CCG published a Commissioning Context document that sets out our commissioning intentions via a clear vision and direction of travel for local services in the Weston and Worle locality
- The overall programme to deliver this is called 'Healthy Weston'
- Our objective is to meet the needs of the local population in a way that is affordable and sustainable

## **We identified three priority population groups:**

1. Frail and older people
2. Children, young people and pregnant women
3. Vulnerable groups e.g. people with mental health needs, learning difficulties and those who struggle with drug and alcohol addiction



# Co-design

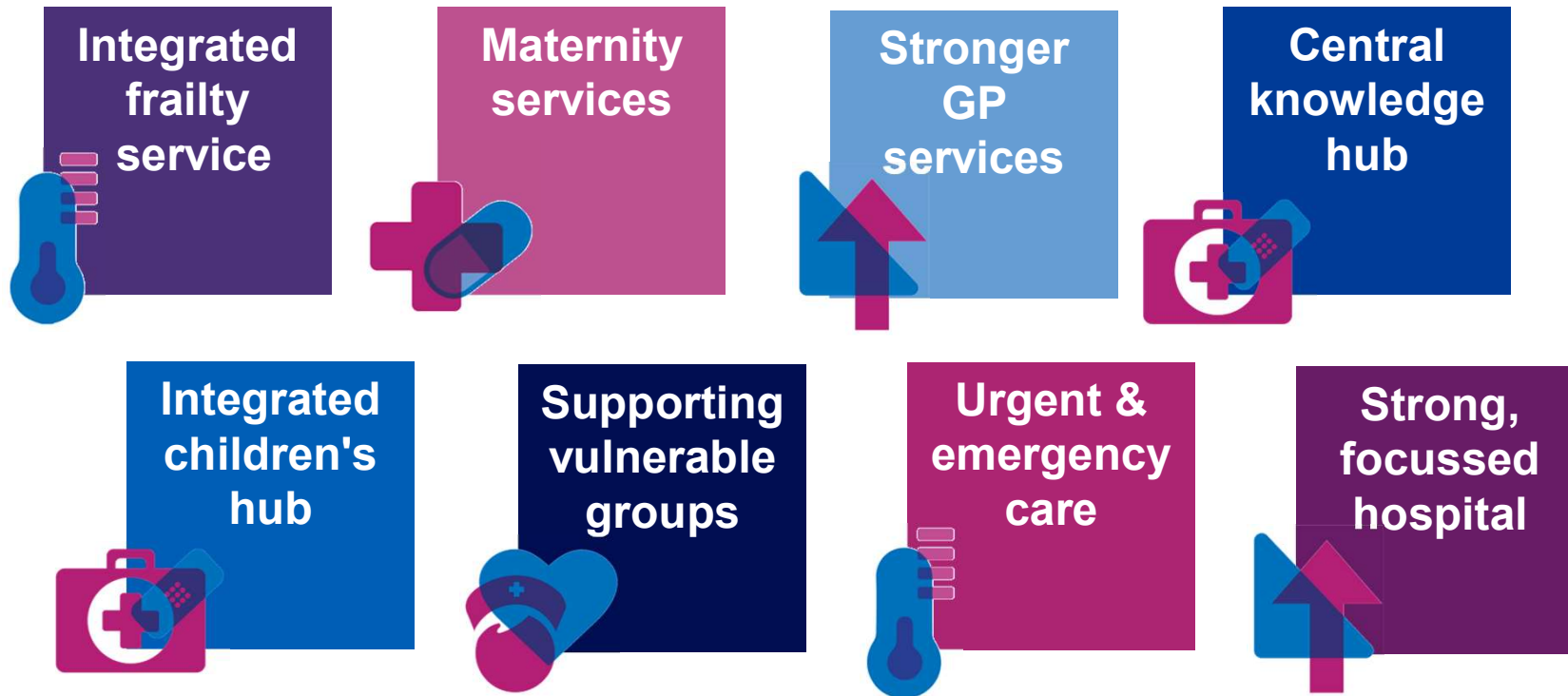
Since the launch of the Commissioning Context in October 2017, we have been engaged in a period of co-design with the local population. This finished in March 2018.

- **1,300** people completed our online survey
- During the course of **46** codesign meetings and workshops, a total of **950** attendees were engaged in face-to-face conversations. Comments were also received via email and social media.
- **1,627** pieces of feedback were received overall, representing **2,518** people

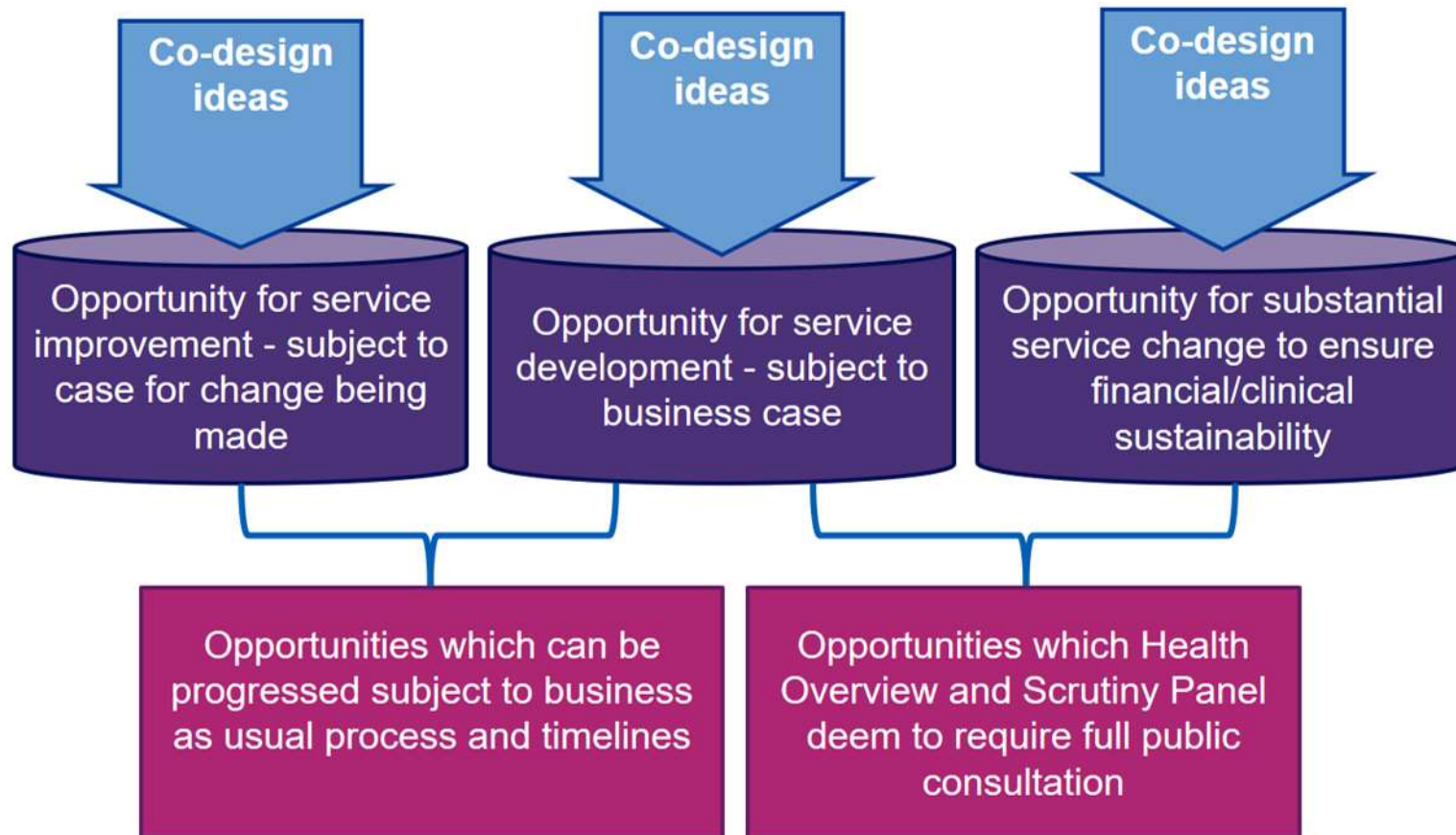
The co-design process produced over 80 ideas, which we have categorised into a number of themes.

# Next steps

- Our **new Locality Structure** will take forward any business as usual ideas that support the delivery of the Healthy Weston vision
  - E.g. the CCG has decided to commission a new **Crisis Café** to support our vulnerable groups
- For any proposals that require public consultation there first needs to be a process by which the South West Clinical Senate test our proposed options, followed by NHS England's regional team
- This process will take place over autumn and early winter
- Our aim is to start public consultation in **January 2019**
