### 2.1 PMS Contract Update

Updated PMS contracts have been issued by NHS England, to reflect the outcome of the PMS Review. Some practices have requested clarification of the documentation prior to signing.

## 5. Practice mergers

### 5.1 Agreed mergers

The following mergers have been approved with varying start dates:

Practices
Christchurch Family Medical Practice and Willow Surgery, merged with effect from 1 <sup>st</sup> April 2018; circa 25,000 pts
Gaywood Surgery; Malago Surgery; Southville Surgery; Wedmore Surgery. Merged with effect from 1 April 2018 to be known as Bridge View Medical; circa 36,000 pts.
St George's Health Centre and Lodgeside Surgery. Merged with effect from 1 April 2018; circa 20,000 pts
Mendip Vale Medical Practice and Riverbank Medical Centre practices were approved to merge on 1 <sup>st</sup> July 2018; circa 35,700 patients
Eastville Medical Practice and Maytrees Practice planned to merge on 1 <sup>st</sup> October 2018; circa 14,000 patients. The practices decided w/c 9.4.18 to postpone these plans. They will review this decision periodically and the medium term intention is still to merge.

## 6. Closed list Applications

### 6.1 Temporary Practice Hour changes

The agreed process has been in place since April 2017, so that the Commissioner can consider temporary practice hour changes. The process covers staff training days etc and allows assurance of the arrangements in place to meet the reasonable needs of patients.

11 practices applied to temporarily change their hours between 1<sup>st</sup> April 2017 and 31 March 2018 – there were 41 applications in total.
